

Students off Monday, back to school Tuesday

The COVID-19 (coronavirus) certainly has created concerns for everyone. I want to ensure our school community that we are in constant communication with our counties' health offices and we are functioning on the most recent information being provided.

At this time, there are no confirmed cases of COVID-19 in our school district or county. However, we must plan for the potential of a long-term closing.

I am announcing that this Monday, March 16, will be a conference day for all staff. All staff is required to report to the Auditorium at 8:15 a.m. Students will not report to school on Monday. Additionally, there will be an emergency Board of Education Meeting at 6:30 p.m. Monday in the Sherburne-Earlville Elementary School Library.

Currently, students and staff are scheduled to report to school on Tuesday, March 17, and each day thereafter, until such time the county health department directs the district to close school. In the event that we are required to close, we would potentially remain closed through the April break and return on April 14.

Please know that the situation surrounding COVID-19 is fluid and may change our plans at any time. I encourage families to plan for a long-term closure, which includes your own childcare needs. I ask that everyone try to remain calm and, rest assured, I will keep you updated through robo calls, social media, and our website.
