

# Frightened by your FAFSA?



High school seniors planning on going on to more education should be filling a FAFSA out this year. The FAFSA is the most important tool available to finance your education, and while the term may be familiar, some don't know what the acronym stands for, or what it does. It sounds complicated, and it feels so important, that it can be overwhelming for many. But it's not as hard or scary as it sounds!

### What is the FAFSA?

The <u>Free Application for Federal Student Aid</u> (FAFSA) is an application used by virtually all two and four-year colleges, universities, and career schools for awarding Federal, state, and college-funded student aid, in the form of grants, loans and work studies. NY state student aid also uses this information to populate information in your state aid application.


### Why do I want to do the FAFSA?

Federal student aid is the best way to pay for college for several reasons. First, you may qualify for grants, which is money the government gives you that you don't need to repay. Any loans you accept,



you will have to repay, but they have lower interest rates and repayment doesn't begin until you graduate or otherwise stop going to school. Also, if you qualify for a subsidized loan, the interest doesn't begin accruing until you leave school.



# 2022-2023 **FREE SAT prep** course at Colgate!!
