Smart Bond Initiative

Passed by New York Voters in November of 2014
Awarded \$2 Billion to all Schools based on
enrollment and state aid formula

Sherburne Earlville's Allocation is \$1,981,022

Rules for these use of these funds

6 categories

- Classroom Connectivity
- Classroom Technology
- Community Connection
- Pre-K Classroom Improvements
- Elimination of Temporary/Trailer Classrooms
- School Security and Safety

What you can't do.....

- You cannot pay salaries
- You cannot pay for software
- You cannot pay for professional development

- You are expected to provide these, but you can't pay for them from the Bond.

S-E Smart School Plan 2017

- In 2017, the Smart School Planning Committee presented and the Board of Education adopted a Smart School Investment Plan with expenditures in three areas:
 - Network Services
 - Classroom Devices
 - High Tech Security

S-E Smart School Plan 2017

- That plan was rejected by NYSED for reconsideration.
- During the interim Sherburne Earlville completed the Network Upgrades and the purchase of Classroom Devices via other funding sources.

S-E Smart School Plan Revisions 2021

- The district is proposing to resubmit the Smart School Investment Plan for the remaining goal of that plan.

Sherburne Earlville Priority 1

- Provide a safe and secure learning environment for all students through a High Tech Security Smart School Project.

Sherburne Earlville Priority 1

- The High Tech Security Smart School Project includes the upgrade of Emergency Classroom Communication via the installation of Digital, IP based, classroom communication.

What happens next ?

1. The Board of Education can adopt this revision of the Final Smart School Plan.
2. Approved plan would be submitted to NYSED.
3. The Plan then churns through NYSED for about 10 to 12 months.
